Upon receipt of notification from LGC Science, Inc., the official testing laboratory for the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission, sample number 0079930 taken from NIGHT LEAGUE, who finished third in the first race at Keeneland on April 27, 2016 contained methocarbamol at a level of 1.5 ng/ml in blood (Class C). After waiving your right to a formal hearing before the Board of Stewards you are hereby suspended FIVE (5) days, May 22, 2016 through May 26, 2016 (inclusive) and fined FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00) DOLLARS. NIGHT LEAGUE is disqualified and all purse money forfeited. Pari-mutuel wagering is not affected by this ruling. During his suspension Mr. Ennis is denied the privileges of all facilities under the jurisdiction of the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission. Entry of all horses owned or trained by Mr. Ennis is denied pending transfer to persons acceptable to the stewards. Upon receipt of this ruling, you are required within thirty (30) days to pay any and all fines imposed to the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission. Failure to do so will subject you to summary suspension of your license pursuant to 810 KAR 1:025 Section 14 (cc).
