After waiving your right to a formal hearing before the Board of Stewards you are hereby fined FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00) DOLLARS. MISSLE BOMB is disqualified and all purse money forfeited. Pari-mutuel wagering is not affected by this ruling. Upon receipt of this ruling, you are required within thirty (30) days to pay any and all fines imposed to the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission.
