Upon receipt of notification from LGC Science, Inc., the official testing laboratory for the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission, sample number 00111018 taken from BLUERIDGE TRAVELER, who finished first in the eighth race at Keeneland on October 20, 2017 contained naproxen in blood (Class C drug). After waiving your right to a formal hearing before the Board of Stewards you are hereby fined FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00) DOLLARS. Pursuant to 810 KAR 1:028 Section 2, subsection (13) "If a person is charged with committing multiple or successive overages involving a Class C or D drug the stewards or the commission may charge the person with only one offense if the person demonstrates that he was not aware that the overages were being administered because the positive test results showing the overages were unavailable to the person charged". BLUERIDGE TRAVELER is disqualified and all purse money forfeited. Pari-mutuel wagering is not affected by this ruling. Upon receipt of this ruling, you are required within thirty (30) days to pay any and all fines imposed to the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission. Failure to do so will subject you to summary suspension of your license pursuant to 810 KAR 1:025 Section 14 (cc).
