By email dated July 30, 2014, the Red Mile requested permission to change the minimum denomination for the Super High Five wager from \$0.10 to \$0.20. The Red Mile had requested the \$0.10 minimum in its 2014 track application, which was approved by the KHRC. KHRC staff confirmed that the \$0.20 minimum complies with KHRC rules.

The Kentucky Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association hereby approves Kentucky Downs' request to simulcast single and full card races to all facilities requesting same during the 2014 Kentucky Downs Fall Meeting, subject to the conditions listed below with the following exceptions:

- o Indiana Downs -Clarksville OTB Outlet (only)
- o Colonial Downs - EZ Horseplay Phone Bet (CDP)- Virginia
- o Bluffs Run Greyhound Track- Iowa
- o Mystique Dubuque Greyhound Park- Iowa

This consent is given pursuant to our present contract and expressly conditioned on the understanding (1) that any thoroughbred racetrack approved as an interstate off-track betting (OTB) outlet maintains a contract with the applicable thoroughbred horsemen's group as defined in the 1978 Interstate Horseracing Act, (2) that present circumstances at any approved OTB outlet do not materially change hereafter such that live thoroughbred horseracing becomes threatened or adversely affected; (3) that no approved OTB outlet combines with other OTB outlets to threaten not to, or refuse to purchase interstate simulcasts except upon similar terms and conditions for purchase being made to each of any combination of such outlets; and (4) that all approved OTB outlets obtain all other consents or approvals required by the 1978 Interstate Horseracing Act.

Kentucky HBPA expressly reserves the right to rescind the consent hereafter should any of the foregoing conditions be violated. Furthermore, re-dissemination of any interstate simulcast for off-track wagering purposes to any OTB outlet not specifically identified in the original or any amended requests for consent of the Kentucky HBPA is prohibited without express notice to, and further consent being obtained from Kentucky HBPA and is

expressly subject to, and conditioned upon, the following terms, conditions and restrictions.

1. That KD maintains transparency with KHBPA and provides to KHBPA, upon request, copies of any and all contracts or written understandings with any person, entity, agent, broker or subsidiary, having anything to do with the offer, negotiation, sale, purchase or transmission of simulcasting and/or off-track wagering rights on races occurring at the KD Racetrack and/or on races occurring at any other racetrack and simulcast to the KD Racetrack for off-tracking wagering through KD. To avoid any doubt, KD may not enter into, or alternatively, must obtain waiver from, any contractual clause or provision that treats as proprietary or confidential (so as to prevent or exclude KHBPA from viewing) any contract with any person or entity dealing with the offer, negotiation, sale, purchase or transmission of simulcasting or off-track wagering rights with regard to any live or simulcast race on which KD accepts wagers;
2. That KD authorizes and requires its tote providers and advance deposit wagering (ADW) providers to make the industry standard "TRA Settlement (ISA) Files" (tote) and "CAW Data Files" (ADW) for all wagering during KD Fall 2014 Race Meet, readily available to the KHBPA from which said files, the KHBPA may be able to check the accuracy of contributions and distributions to the Horsemen's purse account at the KD Racetrack and evaluate the KHBPA's contracting situation with KD.
3. That no approved site included on the site list re-broadcasts or re-disseminates the simulcasts signals from the KD Racetrack for off-track betting purposes to any other site, location or outlet not expressly disclosed in the site list. The KHBPA does not authorize any approved site to re-broadcast or re-disseminate the simulcast signals from the KD Racetrack for off-track betting purposes to any other site not expressly listed. Any approved site that re-broadcasts or re-disseminates simulcasts for betting purposes to any other site not disclosed or so listed without the express written authorization of the KHBPA is expressly prohibited. In the event an approved site re-broadcasts or re-disseminates simulcasts without first obtaining KHBPA's authorization, KHBPA's export approval for such site to accept any off-track wagers on the KD Racetrack's live races occurring during the Fall 2014 Race Meet shall be deemed automatically rescinded, and thus null, void and non-existent as of the date of the first unauthorized re-broadcast or re-dissemination.

KD sending a simulcast for off-track betting purposes to any domestic or international site disclosed or undisclosed in the above-referenced site list shall constitute acceptance of all terms and conditions set forth in this approval/consent letter. KHBPA expressly reserves the right to rescind the consent or approval granted to any particular site in this letter on any subsequent date in the event any of the terms, conditions or restrictions set forth in this letter are violated or become or remain unsatisfied as determined by the KHBPA in its sole discretion.

DATE PREFERENCE SYSTEM

The Date System of preference will be used at Churchill Downs as described below. Foal Certificates are no longer required to be on file in the racing office to enter or start at Churchill Downs; however, foal certificates must be on file to obtain a preference date and to get a horse tattooed.

Preference by condition eligibility then by:

1. In over-filled races, preference will be given to horses in order of their assigned preference dates, earliest date first. Horses having identical dates will be chosen by lot, however, where entry and running dates are the same, the horse with the entry date will have preference.
2. All horses intended for racing at Churchill Downs will be assigned a preference date. Dates assigned will be of two types:

- a) The day on which a horse's foal papers and name tag are submitted to the identifier (the earliest date being the day when entries are first taken for the meeting).
- b) the day on which a horse is first entered if his papers are not on file with the identifier.

To qualify for the latter E-Date, a horse must have been excluded from a race which appears

on the overnight or he must have been entered in a condition book race which failed to fill through insufficient entries.

R-Date

This date will correspond to the day of a horse's most recent race at Churchill Downs. An R-Date will also be assigned to a horse which scratches.

3. A horse retains his R-Date until he receives a newer R-Date. No horse with an established R-Date may receive an E-Date. A horse whose papers are removed from the identifier's office will lose his date and must subsequently re-establish a date in order to receive preference. A horse with an E-Date cannot receive a newer E-Date. Horses starting at another racetrack will forfeit any date they may have at Churchill Downs.
4. Preference dates will consist of two categories: Dirt (D) and Turf (T). Preference dates are good for any type of race or distance.
5. A horse that runs in a race, which has been taken off the Turf will retain its Turf date and establish a Dirt R-Date. A scratched horse will receive an R-Date from the date scratched for both Turf and Dirt.

6. When a race is taken off the Turf, Main Track Only (MTO) horses will receive an R-Date if they run or scratch. If the race remains on the Turf, MTO horses will retain their previous date.
7. Horses on the Also-Eligible list shall be permitted to draw into races in order listed. A horse entered as MTO shall be listed as an Also-Eligible. If the race remains on the Turf, a horse listed as MTO shall not be permitted to draw into the race.
8. No E-Date will be assigned to the second choice of an unsplit same-owner entry.
9. A horse which has been placed on a list (veterinarian, steward, starter or paddock judge) will lose their date and be assigned an R-Date corresponding to the day removed from list.
10. A horse which is a scheduled starter in a canceled race will not receive an R-Date for that race but will retain its previous date.
11. Stakes and handicap races are not subject to date preference.
12. Preference dates are transferred through change of ownership and changes in trainer after the proper transfer procedure have been completed through the Steward's office and delivered to the Racing Secretary's Office.
13. Date preference rules will not supersede K-RC rules regarding preference, eligibility or scratches.
14. Winners will be preferred in all non- maiden races.


Horses which have been excluded from races shall be given preference the next time they are entered, provided they are in a race of similar distance (under a mile or a mile or over) and with a price range of \$500 either way up to \$8,000; above that \$1,000 either way up to \$15,000; above that \$2,500 either way up to \$25,000, and above that \$5,000. Fillies and mares will be kept separated.

Seventy-two (72) hour entry rule (exceptions: Wednesday's entries on the preceding Saturday; Thursday's entries on the preceding Sunday)

Star only entries will be accepted in two-year-old maiden races only. Trainers may enter up to three star only entries. However, should the race not overfill no stars will be allotted.

SUBJECT: KTDF PURSE STRUCTURE – CHURCHILL DOWNS SEPTEMBER AND NOVEMBER MEETS

On September 3, 2014 the KHRC received the attached letter from Churchill Downs with its amendments to the September meet and upcoming November meet KTDF purse structure request. At the July Commission meeting, Churchill Downs was approved for incremental funding of \$300,000 to be used during the September and November meets. This funding is the result of the legislation that transferred \$1 million from the EDRC to the KTDF.

September Amendment:

Prior to the start of the September meet, Churchill Downs had a deficit from the spring/summer meet of \$104,576.62. Rather than reduce purses in the September and November meets, Churchill Downs is requesting to use \$105,000 of the \$300,000 incremental KTDF funding to cover this shortfall. Additionally, Churchill Downs projected KTDF purses for the September meet in the range of \$176,000-\$235,000. This was approved at the July Commission meeting. Churchill Downs is requesting to use an additional \$75,000 of the incremental funding during the September meet. This will increase KTDF offerings to \$251,900.

November Projections:

Churchill Downs plans to card KTDF races in the range of \$600,000 - \$750,000. KHRC staff agrees that at the end of the 2014 September meet, it is anticipated Churchill Downs will have a zero balance. Churchill Downs projections equate to a range of \$23,077 to \$28,846 of KTDF offerings per day. The projections include the remaining \$120,000 of the incremental funding.



The KTDF Advisory Committee met & reviewed the proposals on September 5, 2014.


Churchill Downs needs to review three items related to 2014 KTDF purse amounts:

1. For the Spring meet, Churchill Downs earned \$1,102,828.93 in KTDF purses but paid out \$1,187,460.67 in purses. In addition, Churchill began the 2014 year with a \$19,975 deficit in KTDF on the balance sheet. The combined deficit at this point is \$104,606.74, less than the \$125k previously discussed. Rather than cut September and/or November KTDF funding, Churchill Downs is requesting to first use \$105,000 of the \$300,000 incremental KTDF funding to cover this shortfall.
2. Churchill Downs previously reviewed projections for the September meet purse offerings to be in the range of \$176,000 to \$235,000. Also previously reviewed was the intention to use the remaining amount of the \$300,000 allotment across the September and November meets. The September condition book is published with KTDF purse offering amounts totaling \$251,900 as we plan to use \$75,000 of the remaining incremental KTDF funding in September.
3. Churchill Downs needs to also review the purse amounts for the upcoming Fall meet, consisting of 26 race days from October 26th to November 30th.
 - a. Utilizing the projected remaining \$120,000 of the incremental funding as well as the KTDF earnings from the November meet itself, Churchill Downs plans to card purses in the range of \$600,000 to \$750,000. These purse amounts compare to 2013 Fall KTDF offerings of \$649,100 and disbursements of \$519,551.
 - b. Depending upon the range above, this equates to KTDF purse offering amounts of \$23,077 to \$28,846 per day.
 - c. Churchill Downs feels confident with these projections but may need to revise depending upon the actual handle trends seen during the September meet.

At the July Commission meeting, Keeneland was approved for incremental funding of \$300,000 to be used during the 2014 fall meet and 2015 spring meet. This funding is the result of the legislation that transferred \$1 million from the EDRC to the KTDF.

KHRC staff confirms that at the end of the 2014 spring meet, Keeneland had a deficit \$392. Keeneland proposed KTDF purses in the amount of \$572,194. Keeneland projections are based on a payout of approximately 78% of the amount carded. Keeneland anticipates using \$80,000 - \$100,000 of the \$300,000 approved EDRC funds.

The KTDF Advisory Committee met & reviewed the proposal on September 5, 2014. Approval is recommended.

Keeneland has reviewed our KTDF data and would like to card approximately \$572,194 in KTDF money for our upcoming October meet. We have determined this number based on the following information:


1. We had a deficit of \$392 following the Spring meet.
2. We are projecting approximate daily earnings of 21,688.
3. We are assuming a payout percentage of approximately 78% of the amount carded;
4. We anticipate that KTDF purses will be approximately 13.5% of the purses for the races that are eligible for KTDF.

Keeneland will pay out KTDF funds through last place. A table containing the payout percentage by field size is attached.

We will evaluate the earnings and payout percentages several days into our race meet and may need to make adjustments if our actual earnings and payout percentages are significantly different from our assumptions.

On August 14, 2014 the KHRC received the attached letter from Turfway Park with its upcoming 2014 holiday meet and 2015 winter/spring meet KTDF purse structure request. At the July Commission meeting, Turfway Park was approved for incremental funding of \$100,000 to be used during the 2014 holiday and 2015 winter/spring meets. This funding is the result of the legislation that transferred \$1 million from the EDRC to the KTDF.

KHRC staff confirms that at the end of the 2014 winter/spring meet, Turfway Park had a surplus of \$532,064. Turfway Park proposed KTDF purses in the amount of \$2,139,490. Turfway Park's projections are based on a payout of approximately 75% of the amount carded. Turfway Park intends to use the full \$100,000 of the approved EDRC funds.

The KTDF Advisory Committee met & reviewed the proposal on September 5, 2014. Approval is recommended.

Mr. Ward,

At the end of our 2014 Winter/Spring meet, Turfway Park had a KTDF surplus of \$532,064. We are requesting that the Commission approve payments from our account of \$2,139,490 for our 2014 Holiday and 2015 Winter/Spring meets. This would leave an anticipated surplus in our account of roughly \$32,447 at the conclusion of the meet.

This request includes \$340,000 KTDF funds to be allocated to our stakes program (includes the additional \$100,000 in KTDF funds that were allotted to Turfway Park by the KTDF Advisory committee on June 24th).

Please allow us to exceed the 85% ceiling since funds are available. Our current request assumes a payout of approximately 100% of association purses and an expectation to payout 75% of KTDF funds as presented in the condition book. Additionally, KTDF figures reflect a purse increase of 20% (overnight races) from the December meet in 2013.

Consistent with other thoroughbred tracks, Turfway will pay out KTDF funds through last place as follows: 1st place – 60%; 2nd place – 20%; 3rd place – 10%; 4th place – 5%; 5th place – 3%; Remaining 2% divided evenly among starters.

Should we determine that more or less funds will actually be available than our current estimates, we would like the latitude to notify the Commission and adjust accordingly. In no event will we exceed the funds available to us.



