Date Preference System

The following date system of preference is used at Turfway Park:

Foal certificates no longer are required to be on file in the racing office to enter or start at Turfway Park; however, foal certificates must be on file to obtain a preference date and to have a horse tattooed.

Each day's overnight will list the dates of horses in and on the also-eligible list to enable trainers to see what dates are getting horses into over-filled races.

1. In over-filled races, preference will be given to horses in order of their assigned preference dates, earliest date first. Horses having identical dates will be chosen by lot; however, where entry and running dates are the same, the horse with the entry date will have preference.

2. All horses intended for racing at Turfway Park will be assigned a preference date. A horse can have only one date at any particular time. Dates assigned will be of two types:

E-Date

This date will correspond to: (a) the date on which a horse's foal papers and name card are submitted to the Identifier (the earliest date being the day when entries are first taken for the meeting); (b) the day on which a horse is first entered if his papers are not on file with the Identifier. To qualify for the latter E-Date, a horse must have been excluded from a race that appears on the overnight or he must have been entered in a condition book race that failed to fill through insufficient entries.

R-Date

This date will correspond to the day of a horse's most recent race at Turfway Park. An R-Date will also be assigned to a horse that scratches.

3. A horse retains his R-Date until he receives a newer R-Date. No horse with an established R-Date may receive an E-Date. A horse whose papers are removed from the Identifier's office will lose his date and must subsequently re-establish a date in order to receive preference. A horse with an E-Date cannot receive a newer E-Date. Horses starting at another racetrack will forfeit any date they may have at Turfway Park. Additionally, horses racing at Turfway Park without foal papers on site will not retain their R-Date.

4. Preference dates are good for any type of race or distance (other than maiden dates).

5. Maiden dates will be kept separately and will not have preference in winners' races.

6. No E-Date will be assigned to the second choice of an un-split same-owner entry.

7. A horse that has been placed on a list (Veterinarian, Steward, Starter, or Paddock Judge) will lose his date and be assigned an R-Date corresponding to the day he is removed from the list.

8. Horses on the Also-Eligible list shall be permitted to draw into races and will be assigned post positions in the order of their dates, earliest dates first.

9. A horse that is a scheduled starter in a canceled race will not receive an R-Date for that race but will retain his previous date.

10. The draw of stake and handicap races is not subject to date preference.

11. Preference dates are transferred through change in ownership and changes in trainer only after the proper transfer procedures have been completed through the Stewards' Office and delivered to the Racing Secretary's Office.

12. Date preference rules will not supercede KHRC rules regarding preference, eligibility, or scratches.

Dear John,

At the end of our Winter/Spring Meet of 2013, we had a surplus in our KTDF account of \$478,906.51 per confirmation from Jamie Eads. We would like to request that the Commission approve payments from our account of \$464,000 for our Holiday Meet. This would leave an anticipated surplus in our account of \$14,906.51 prior to any Holiday Meet earnings. No KTDF funds will be applied to Stakes races.

Please allow us to exceed the 85% ceiling since funds are available. Our current request assumes a payout of approximately 100% of association purses and an expectation to payout 75% of KTDF funds as presented in the condition book.

Consistent with other thoroughbred tracks, Turfway will pay out KTDF funds through last place as follows: 1st place – 60%; 2nd place – 20%; 3rd place – 10%; 4th place – 5%; 5th place – 3%; Remaining 2% divided evenly among starters.

Should we determine that more or less funds will actually be available than our current estimates, we would like the latitude to notify the Commission and adjust accordingly. In no event will we exceed the funds available to us.

Committee Members:

Churchill Downs has reviewed our KTDF data and would like to card KTDF purses in the range of \$625,000 to \$675,000 for our upcoming fall meet. We have based the range on the following information:

1. Churchill Downs has a surplus balance of \$71,863 at the end of our 2013 Homecoming Meet. This balance is down 50% from our ending 2012 spring meet balance of \$143,277.
2. In the 2012 fall meet, we offered \$738,100 in KTDF purses and paid \$579,865 in KTDF purses. KTDF purses in the 2012 fall meet were supplemented by monies associated with the instant racing activity from 2012 and are contributing to the decline in KTDF offerings from 2012.
3. We are projecting daily earnings of \$18,651, which is 5.6% lower than the \$19,762 earned in 2012 and reflects the addition of four race days.
4. We are assuming a KTDF payout percentage of 79%, which is also consistent with our payout percentage from the 2012 fall meet.
5. To encourage participation, during the fall meet, we are planning to pay KTDF purses from first to last to all eligible horses instead of the traditional first to fourth.

SUBJECT: 2014 KENTUCKY SIRE STAKES PURSE DISTRIBUTIONS

On September 19, 2013, the Kentucky Standardbred Development Fund Advisory Panel met and approved the 2014 Kentucky Sire Stakes purse distributions as follows:

Legs: \$15,000, \$10,000 split
Finals: \$175,000

The Kentucky Sire Stakes is a culmination of a month-long series of preliminary races, with the biggest money earners getting a chance to compete in one of the riches finals in North America. The series includes two-and-three year-old pacers and trotters.

Additionally the Advisory Panel recommends \$140,000 is transferred to the Kentucky County Fairs to be used for purse allocations on Fairs in Kentucky.

The following is a brief description of the funds for informational purposes:

Kentucky Standardbred Development Fund (KSDF):

This fund was established to promote races and to provide purses for races for horses sired by stallions standing within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. The fund is to be distributed to persons, corporations or associations operating licensed standardbred race tracks within Kentucky on an equitable basis, for the purposes of conducting separate races for two and three year old fillies and colts, both trotting



and pacing, sired by standardbred stallions standing within in the Commonwealth of Kentucky at the time of conception. The KSDF receives its revenue from the Kentucky Standardbred Breeders' Incentive Fund (KySBIF) and 1% of the total live handle of harness racing, 2% of all simulcast wagering and .70% of the 4% commission set aside for the County Fair Purse Fund.

Kentucky Standardbred Breeders' Incentive Fund (KySBIF):

The Kentucky Standardbred Breeders' Incentive Fund is financed from the 13% of all receipts collected from the sales and use tax on the fees paid for breeding a stallion to a mare in Kentucky, together with any other money contributed, appropriated, or allocated to the fund from all other sources. The money deposited in the KySBIF is used to administer the fund and provide rewards for breeders or owners of Kentucky-bred standardbred horses through the KSDF.

Churchill Downs proposes to introduce a new wager for its meet beginning October 27, 2013. A copy of the proposed wager is attached. At the September 23, 2013 commission meeting, the KHRC staff expressed concerns about the wager. In discussions with Churchill Downs, the following notification to patrons has been agreed upon:

In the UNIQUE Pick-6, if a single patron ends up with the only winning ticket but has more than one such winning combination, regardless of how it occurred, that patron will not be eligible for the UNIQUE Pick-6 Carryover.

This notice is to be provided to patrons in compliance with Churchill Downs' conditions of licensure, which include the following condition:

Each association and OTB is required to post policies and procedures related to pari-mutuel wagering, including the refund policy, on the association or OTB's website. Each association and OTB shall also post a notice in the racing program and a sign at the association's information window informing patrons where they can access a complete copy of the policies and procedures related to pari-mutuel wagering, including the refund policy.

Subject to Churchill's compliance with their conditions of licensure and assurances of dissemination of the agreed upon notice, approval is recommended.

Pick-6 with Unique Carryover

Pick-6 Pools. (1) The Pick-6 requires the selection of the first place finisher in each of six specified races designated by the association and approved by the commission. Any changes to the Pick-6 format shall be approved by the commission before implementation.

(2) The Pick-6 pari-mutuel pool consists of amounts contributed for a win only selection in each of six (6) races designated by the association. Each individual placing a Pick-6 wager shall designate the winning horse in each of six (6) races comprising the Pick-6.

(3)(a) The entire net Pick-6 pool and the Unique Carryover, if any, shall be distributed only if there is a single wager placed for the required bet minimum that selected the first-place finisher in each of the Pick-6 contests, based upon the official order of finish.

(b) If there is no single winning wager as defined in section (a), a percentage (major share) that has been declared by the Association and approved by KHRC of the net Pick-6 pool for that day shall be distributed as a single price pool as defined below, and the remaining percentage (jackpot share) of the net Pick-6 pool shall be added to the Unique Carryover.

(4) The net Pick-6 pool shall be distributed in the following precedence based upon the official order of finish:

(a) As a single price pool to individuals whose selection finished first in each of the six races, but if there are no such wagers, then;

(b) As a single price pool to individuals who selected the first-place finisher in any five of the six races, but if there are no such wagers, then;

(c) As a single price pool to individuals who selected the first-place finisher in any four of the six races, but if there are no such wagers, then;

(d) As a single price pool to individuals who selected the first-place finisher in any three of the six races, but if there are no such wagers, then;

(e) As a single price pool to individuals who selected the first-place finisher in any two of the six races, but if there are no such wagers, then;

(f) As a single price pool to individuals who selected the first-place finisher in any one of the six races, but if there are no such wagers, then;

(g) The entire pool shall be refunded on Pick-6 wagers for those races.

(5) If for any reason one or two of the races comprising the Pick-6 is cancelled, the net amount of the pari-mutuel pool for that day shall be distributed as provided above in subsections (4) (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f) and (g).

(6) If for any reason three or more races comprising the Pick-6 are cancelled, the entire pool shall be refunded on Pick-6 wagers for those races.

(7) When the condition of the turf course warrants a change of racing surface in any races of the Pick-6, and such change has not been disclosed to the public prior to "off time" of the first race of the Pick-6, the stewards shall declare the changed races an "all win" race for Pick-6 wagering purposes only. An "all win" race will

assign the winner of that race to each Pick-6 ticket holder as their selection for that race. In the event there are two or more races comprising the Pick-6 that are declared "all win," any Unique Carryover and any guaranteed monies shall be removed from that day's calculation.

(8)(a) If there is a dead heat for first in any Pick-6 race involving horses representing the same betting interest, the Pick-6 pool shall be distributed as if no dead heat occurred.

(b) If there is a dead heat for first in any Pick-6 race involving horses representing two or more betting interests, the Pick-6 pool shall be distributed as a single price pool with each winning wager receiving an equal share of the profit.

(9) Should a betting interest in any of the Pick-6 races be scratched, excused, or determined by the stewards to be a non-starter in a race, the actual favorite, as evidenced by total amounts wagered in the win pool at the host association for the race at the close of wagering on that race, shall be substituted for the scratched betting interest for all purposes, including pool calculations.

(a) In the event that the win pool total for two or more favorites is identical, the substitute selection shall be the betting interest with the lowest program number.

(b) The totalizator shall produce reports showing each of the wagering combinations with substituted betting interests which became winners as a result of the substitution, in addition to the normal winning combination.

(10) The Pick-6 pool shall be cancelled and all Pick-6 wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if at least three races included as part of a Pick-6 are cancelled or declared "no contest."

(11)(a) Each association shall disclose in its license application whether it intends to schedule Pick-6 races and, if so, shall disclose:

1. The percentage of the pool to be retained for the winning wagers, and
2. The designated amount of any cap to be set on the pool to be retained for the winning wagers.

(b) Any changes to the Pick-6 scheduling require prior approval from the commission or its designee.

(12)(a) The Unique Pick-6 carryover, if any, may be capped at a designated level approved by the commission so that if, at the close of any performance, the amount in the Unique Pick-6 carryover equals or exceeds the designated cap, the Unique Pick-6 carryover will be frozen until it is won or distributed under the provisions of this administrative regulation.

(b) After the Unique Pick-6 carryover is frozen, one hundred percent (100%) of the net pool, part of which ordinarily would be added to the Unique Pick-6 carryover, shall be distributed to individuals whose selections finished first in the greatest number of Pick-6 races for that performance.

(13) An association may request permission from the commission to distribute all of the Unique Pick-6 carryover or a portion of the Unique Pick-6 carryover on a specific performance. The request shall contain justification for the

distribution, an explanation of the benefit to be derived, and the intended date and performance for the distribution.

(14) If the Unique Pick-6 carryover or a portion of the Unique Pick-6 carryover, is designated for distribution on a specified date and performance, and no wagers correctly select the first-place finisher in each of the Pick-6 races, the entire net pool plus the Unique Pick-6 carryover designated for distribution on that date shall be distributed as a single price pool to individuals whose selection finished first in the greatest number of Pick-6 races.

(15) The Unique Pick-6 carryover shall be designated for distribution on a specified date and performance only under the following circumstances:

(a) Upon written approval from the commission as provided in subsection (8) of this section; or

(b) Upon written approval from the commission when there is a change in the carryover cap; or

(c) A change from Pick-6 wagering to another type of Pick-(N) wagering; or

(d) When the Pick-6 is discontinued; or

(e) On the closing performance of the meeting or split meeting.

(16) If, for any reason, the Unique Pick-6 carryover shall be held over to the corresponding Unique Pick-6 pool of a subsequent meeting, the carryover shall be deposited in an interest-bearing account approved by the commission. The Unique Pick-6 carryover plus accrued interest shall then be added to the net Pick-6 pool of the following meeting on a date and performance approved by the commission.

(17) Upon written approval of the commission, a sum of money up to the amount of any designated cap may be contributed to the Pick-6 carryover by an association.

(18) Upon written approval of the commission, the Association may seed the Unique carryover and may recover the amount seeded by subtracting funds from each day's unique carryover until the amount seeded has been recovered.

(19) The association may supply information to the general public regarding the winning dollars in the Pick-6 pool. Such information shall not be selectively distributed. This shall not prohibit necessary communication between totalizator and pari-mutuel department employees for processing of pool data.
