Date Preference System

The following date system of preference is used at Turfway Park:

Foal certificates no longer are required to be on file in the racing office to enter or start at Turfway Park; however, foal certificates must be on file to obtain a preference date and to have a horse tattooed.

Each day's overnight will list the dates of horses in and on the also-eligible list to enable trainers to see what dates are getting horses into over-filled races.

1. In over-filled races, preference will be given to horses in order of their assigned preference dates, earliest date first. Horses having identical dates will be chosen by lot; however, where entry and running dates are the same, the horse with the entry date will have preference.

2. All horses intended for racing at Turfway Park will be assigned a preference date. A horse can have only one date at any particular time. Dates assigned will be of two types:

E-Date

This date will correspond to: (a) the date on which a horse's foal papers and name card are submitted to the Identifier (the earliest date being the day when entries are first taken for the meeting); (b) the day on which a horse is first entered if his papers are not on file with the Identifier. To qualify for the latter E-Date, a horse must have been excluded from a race that appears on the overnight or he must have been entered in a condition book race that failed to fill through insufficient entries.

R-Date

This date will correspond to the day of a horse's most recent race at Turfway Park. An R-Date will also be assigned to a horse that scratches.

3. A horse retains his R-Date until he receives a newer R-Date. No horse with an established R-Date may receive an E-Date. A horse whose papers are removed from the Identifier's office will lose his date and must subsequently re-establish a date in order to receive preference. A horse with an E-Date cannot receive a newer E-Date. Horses starting at another racetrack will forfeit any date they may have at Turfway Park. Additionally, horses racing at Turfway Park without foal papers on site will not retain their R-Date.

4. Preference dates are good for any type of race or distance (other than maiden dates).

5. Maiden dates will be kept separately and will not have preference in winners' races.

6. No E-Date will be assigned to the second choice of an un-split same-owner entry.

7. A horse that has been placed on a list (Veterinarian, Steward, Starter, or Paddock Judge) will lose his date and be assigned an R-Date corresponding to the day he is removed from the list.

8. Horses on the Also-Eligible list shall be permitted to draw into races and will be assigned post positions in the order of their dates, earliest dates first.

9. A horse that is a scheduled starter in a canceled race will not receive an R-Date for that race but will retain his previous date.

10. The draw of stake and handicap races is not subject to date preference.

11. Preference dates are transferred through change in ownership and changes in trainer only after the proper transfer procedures have been completed through the Stewards' Office and delivered to the Racing Secretary's Office.

12. Date preference rules will not supersede KHRC rules regarding preference, eligibility, or scratches.

NEW LOCATION FOR THE RACING SECRETARY'S OFFICE & THE CLAIMS CLERK

The new location is behind the Paddock, adjacent to the Horsemen's Service Center.
The Claims Box is located in the new Racing Secretary's Office.

LASIX

Section 6. Furosemide Use on Race Day.

- (1) Furosemide may be administered, in accordance with this section, to a horse that is entered to compete in a race.
- (2) The commission veterinarian shall administer furosemide prior to a race.
- (3) Furosemide may be used under the following circumstances:
 - (a) Furosemide shall be administered at a location under the jurisdiction of the commission, by a single intravenous injection, not less than four (4) hours prior to post time for the race in which the horse is entered.
 - (b) The furosemide dosage administered shall not exceed 500 mg, nor be less than 150 mg.
- (4) The initial cost of administering the furosemide shall be twenty (20) dollars per administration.

Payment: The Horsemen's Bookkeeper will collect the Salix administration fee from the owner's account.

DATE PREFERENCE SYSTEM

The Date System of preference will be used at Churchill Downs as described below:

Foal Certificates are no longer required to be on file in the racing office to enter or start at Churchill Downs; however, foal certificates must be on file to obtain a preference date and to get a horse tattooed.

Preference by condition eligibility then by:

1. In over-filled races, preference will be given to horses in order of their assigned preference dates, earliest date first. Horses having identical dates will be chosen by lot, however, where entry and running dates are the same, the horse with the entry date will have preference.
2. All horses intended for racing at Churchill Downs will be assigned a preference date. Dates assigned will be of two types:

E-Date

This date will correspond to:

- a) the day on which a horse's foal papers and name tag are submitted to the identifier (the earliest date being the day when entries are first taken for the meeting).
- b) the day on which a horse is first entered if his papers are not on file with the identifier.

To qualify for the latter E-Date, a horse must have been excluded from a race which appears

on the overnight or he must have been entered in a condition book race which failed to fill through insufficient entries.

R-Date

This date will correspond to the day of a horse's most recent race at Churchill Downs.

An R-Date will also be assigned to a horse which scratches.

3. A horse retains his R-Date until he receives a newer R-Date. No horse with an established R-Date may receive an E-Date. A horse whose papers are removed from the identifier's office will lose his date and must subsequently re-establish a date in order to receive preference. A horse with an E-Date cannot receive a newer E-Date. Horses starting at another racetrack will forfeit any date they may have at Churchill Downs.
4. Preference dates will consist of two categories: Dirt (D) and Turf (T). Preference dates are good for any type of race or distance.
5. A horse that runs in a race, which has been taken off the Turf will retain its Turf date and establish a Dirt R-Date. A scratched horse will receive an R-Date from the date scratched for both Turf and Dirt.
6. When a race is taken off the Turf, Main Track Only (MTO) horses will receive an R-Date if they run or scratch. If the race remains on the Turf, MTO horses will retain their previous date.
7. Horses on the Also-Eligible list shall be permitted to draw into races in order listed. A horse entered as MTO shall be listed as an Also-Eligible. If the race remains on the Turf, a horse listed as MTO shall not be permitted to draw into the race.
8. No E-Date will be assigned to the second choice of an unsplit same-owner entry.
9. A horse which has been placed on a list (veterinarian, steward, starter or paddock judge) will lose their date and be assigned an R-Date corresponding to the day removed from list.
10. A horse which is a scheduled starter in a canceled race will not receive an R-Date for that race but will retain its previous date.
11. Stakes and handicap races are not subject to date preference.
12. Preference dates are transferred through change of ownership and changes in trainer after the proper transfer procedure have been completed through the Steward's office and delivered to the Racing Secretary's Office.
13. Date preference rules will not supersede KHRC rules regarding preference, eligibility or scratches.
14. Winners will be preferred in all non- maiden races.

SUBJECT: 2015 KENTUCKY SIRE STAKES PURSE DISTRIBUTIONS

On September 16, 2014, the Kentucky Standardbred Development Fund & Kentucky Standardbred Breeders' Incentive Fund Advisory Panel met and approved the 2015 Kentucky Sire Stakes purse distributions as follows:

Legs: \$15,000, \$10,000 split
Finals: \$175,000

The Kentucky Sire Stakes is a culmination of a month-long series of preliminary races, with the biggest money earners getting a chance to compete in the finals at The Red Mile. The series includes two-and-three year-old pacers and trotters for both fillies & colts.

Additionally the Advisory Panel recommends \$140,000 plus \$1,000 per KY Fair to be transferred to the Kentucky County Fairs to be used for purse allocations on Fairs in Kentucky. The Kentucky County Fairs will be approved at a future Commission meeting. It is estimated there will be seven (7) county fairs & one (1) fair final for a total of eight (8). This is the same number of fairs in 2014.

The following is a brief description of the funds for informational purposes:

Kentucky Standardbred Development Fund (KSDF):

This fund was established to promote races and to provide purses for races for horses sired by stallions standing within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. The fund is to be distributed to persons, corporations or associations operating licensed standardbred race tracks within Kentucky on an equitable basis, for the purposes of



conducting separate races for two and three year old fillies and colts, both trotting and pacing, sired by standardbred stallions standing within in the Commonwealth of Kentucky at the time of conception. The KSDF receives its revenue from the Kentucky Standardbred Breeders' Incentive Fund (KySBIF) and 1% of the total live handle of harness racing, 2% of all simulcast wagering and .70% of the 4% commission set aside for the County Fair Purse Fund.

Kentucky Standardbred Breeders' Incentive Fund (KySBIF):

The Kentucky Standardbred Breeders' Incentive Fund is financed from the 13% of all receipts collected from the sales and use tax on the fees paid for breeding a stallion to a mare in Kentucky, together with any other money contributed, appropriated, or allocated to the fund from all other sources. The money deposited in the KySBIF is used to administer the fund and provide rewards for breeders or owners of Kentucky-bred standardbred horses through the KSDF.

SUBJECT: BACKSIDE IMPROVEMENT FUND: Churchill Downs, Inc.

On October 10, 2014, the KHRC received the attached letter from Churchill Downs. Churchill Downs is seeking permission from the Commission to approve renovations to restrooms on the backside. These updates are necessary to ensure the quality of the environment for the people on the backside. Churchill Downs has included photographs and one bid. The total cost for this project is \$10,870. On October 10, 2014, Daniel Hyland (KHRC) inspected the backside restrooms included in this project and confirms the work is necessary. As noted in the letter from Churchill, both KTA and the KyHBPA support this project.

KHRC staff confirms Churchill Downs has \$357,651.24 in the Backside Improvement Fund from FY14. Upon completion of the project, KHRC staff will inspect the renovations and confirm the project has been completed. All invoices, photographs and communication will be kept on file for Commission review.




Conditions of Racing Association and Off-Track Betting (OTB) Facility

Licensing for 2015

Kentucky Horse Racing Commission

As a condition of the issuance by the KHRC of a license to conduct horse racing and to operate as a Kentucky OTB during the 2015⁴ racing year, each Kentucky racing association and Kentucky OTB shall be required to certify that it will comply with the following requirements:

- 1) Each racing association and OTB shall notify the KHRC of any communication, report, or investigation conducted by the Thoroughbred Racing Association (TRA) or Thoroughbred Racing Protective Bureau (TRPB), or any state or federal regulatory agency that relates to the safety, integrity, or security of the racing association or OTB, and its participants, or that would reasonably be deemed to affect public confidence in the racing association or OTB. Each racing association and OTB shall further send a copy of any TRA, TRPB, or governmental communications, correspondence, or reports relating to any such report or investigation to the KHRC within 24 hours of receipt by the racing association or OTB. This paragraph shall not be construed to include information delivered to racing association officials acting in the capacity of members of the board of directors of TRA or TRPB.
- 2) Each racing association and OTB shall notify the KHRC any time a member of a local, state or federal law enforcement agency enters association grounds for the purpose of questioning, investigating or arresting a licensed individual. Each racing association and OTB shall further send a copy of any reports related to the questioning, investigation or arrest prepared by the racing association or OTB or prepared by the law enforcement agency to the KHRC within 24 hours of receipt by the racing association or OTB.
- 3) Each racing association and OTB shall send a copy of any self-reporting documents, forms, or correspondence to the KHRC at the same time they are filed with the TRA, TRPB, state or federal regulatory agency with the exception of any information that is proprietary to the racing association or OTB or has no relevance to the safety, integrity, or security of the racing association or OTB. The racing association or OTB shall identify to the KHRC any information the racing association or OTB considers proprietary or irrelevant to the safety, integrity, or security of the racing association or OTB.
- 4) Each racing association and OTB is required to notify the KHRC if it becomes aware of a wagering anomaly related to racing conducted at that association or related to a race imported for simulcast wagering at the association or OTB, even if a report has not been filed with the TRA or TRPB. The racing association or OTB

shall provide transactional data and video of the race to the KHRC upon request. Wagering anomalies include any incident that might reasonably affect the public's confidence in the racing association's or OTB's wagering pools, such as:

- (a) Past posting, cancel delay, and other instances when wagering occurs after the horses have left the gate;
- (b) Off-shore and Account wagering fraud;
- (c) Suspected manipulation through computerized robotic wagering;
- (d) Odds manipulation;
- (e) Win pool odds manipulation;
- (f) Arbitrage;
- (g) Quick pick or random pick malfunction;
- (h) Unusually large wagers (especially right as the betting stops);
- (i) Unusually large cancellation of wagers (especially right as the betting stops);
- (j) Outlets that are habitually late getting into the pools;
- (k) Manual merges;
- (l) Unusual payoffs;
- (m) Failing to remove a scratched horse from the pools (which would then require a re-calculation of payoffs);
- (n) Suspicious wagering patterns;
- (o) Totalizator or data communications malfunctions;
- (p) Substantial late ticket cancellations; and
- (q) Failure to stop wagering after the official start of a race.

The list of wagering anomalies above is meant to be illustrative and not exclusive.

~~5) 5)~~ Each racing association shall record the date and time (in hours, minutes, and seconds) on all live video feeds originating from a Kentucky track. Each racing association shall be responsible for recording (in hours, minutes, and seconds) the start/off time of each race. Further, each racing association shall require the tote company with whom it does business to certify, and provide evidence of such certification, to the Chief State Steward of the time (in hours, minutes, and seconds) of the closing of the betting windows for each race. Records shall be retained for two years after the date of the race. Records shall be submitted to KHRC upon request.

~~5)6)~~ Each racing association shall ensure that the tote company and video provider for its live meet shall be linked up and operating correctly at least 24 hours prior to the start of the live meet.

76) Each racing association, OTB and tote company shall require that each of the timing systems mentioned in paragraph 4 be synchronized with the U.S. Naval Observatory Clock at the beginning of each race day.

87) Each association and OTB is required to authorize their tote vendor to share any and all wagering data requested with the KHRC.

- 98) Each association and OTB is required to post policies and procedures related to pari-mutuel wagering, including the refund policy, on the association or OTB's website. Each association and OTB shall also post a notice in the racing program and a sign at the association's information window informing patrons where they can access a complete copy of the policies and procedures related to pari-mutuel wagering, including the refund policy.
- 10) Each association and OTB shall provide a copy of its mutuel department policies and procedures to the KHRC.
- 110) Each association shall have protocols in place that mandate exclusion of any receiving track's wagering pool when the association cannot verify that all wagers in the receiving track's pool were received prior to the official start of the race. Protocols shall be provided to the KHRC.
- 124) Each association and OTB shall have protocols in place and shall publicize to its wagering patrons when, as a receiving track, it is excluded from a host track's wagering pool. These protocols shall include an immediate public announcement and immediate posting on the association's and OTB's video monitors and websites. Protocols shall be provided to the KHRC.
- 123) Each association and OTB that does business with any individual, person, or other entity that offers advance deposit account wagering ("ADW") to Kentucky residents shall require that ADW to be licensed by the Commonwealth.
- 143) Each association offering thoroughbred racing shall require owners to deposit the \$20 fee for the administration of race-day furosemide into the owner's account with the horsemen's bookkeeper by 12:00 noon on the day of the race. Failure of the owner to deposit such fee may result in the owner being subjected to penalties, including fines or suspension. Each association shall debit the owner's account for the \$20 fee to the credit of the KHRC.
- 154) In the event a racing association and/or OTB does not comply with the requirements of these conditions, the KHRC has the authority to assess fines and/or penalties.
- 165) All notices required to be given to the KHRC under these conditions to licensure shall be provided to the Executive Director, the Chief State Steward/Presiding Judge, and the Supervisor of Pari-Mutuel Wagering immediately by a phone call. In addition, written notice of the event shall be received by the Executive Director no later than 24 hours of the event triggering the notice requirement. Written notice may be made to the Executive Director by hand delivery, electronic mail, or facsimile.
