
Post time for the first race is 1:05 p.m. daily except on Saturday, April 9 and Saturday, April 16 when the first post will be 12:35 p.m. We will hold eight to twelve live races daily.

Horses which have been excluded from races shall be given preference the next time they are entered, provided they are in a race of similar distance (under a mile or a mile or over) and with a price range of \$500 either way up to \$8,000; above that \$1,000 either way up to \$15,000; above that \$2,500 either way up to \$25,000, and above that \$5,000. Fillies and mares will be kept separated.

Star only entries will be accepted in two-year-old maiden races only. Trainers may enter up to three star only entries. However, should the race not overfill no stars will be allotted.



DATE PREFERENCE SYSTEM

The Date System of preference will be used at Churchill Downs as described below:

Foal Certificates no longer are required to be on file in the racing office to enter or start at Churchill Downs; however, foal certificates must be on file to obtain a preference date and to get a horse tattooed.

Each day's overnight will list the dates of horses in and on the also-eligible list to enable trainers to see what dates are getting horses in over-filled races.

1. In over-filled races, preference will be given to horses in order of their assigned preference dates, earliest date first. Horses having identical dates will be chosen by lot, however, where entry and running dates are the same, the horse with the entry date will have preference.
2. All horses intended for racing at Churchill Downs will be assigned a preference date. Dates assigned will be of two types:

E-Date

This date will correspond to:


- a) The day on which a horse's foal papers and name tag are submitted to the identifier (the earliest date being the day when entries are first taken for the meeting).
- b) The day on which a horse is first entered if his papers are not on file with the identifier.

To qualify for the latter E-date, a horse must have been excluded from a race which appears on the overnight or he must have been entered in a condition book race which failed to fill through insufficient entries.

R-Date

This date will correspond to the day of a horse's most recent race at Churchill Downs. An R-Date will also be assigned to a horse which scratches.

3. A horse retains his R-Date until he receives a newer R-Date. No horse with an established R-Date may receive an E-Date. A horse whose papers are removed from the identifier's office will lose his date and must subsequently re-establish a date in order to receive preference. A horse with an E-Date cannot receive a newer E-Date. Horses starting at another race track will forfeit any date they may have at Churchill Downs.
4. Preference dates will consist of two categories: Dirt (D) and Turf (T). Preference dates are good for any type of race or distance.
5. A horse that runs in a race, which has been taken off the turf will retain its turf date. A scratched horse will receive an R-date from the date scratched.
6. When a race is taken off the turf, dirt preferred horses will receive an R-Date if they run or scratch. If the race remains on the turf, dirt preferred horses will retain their previous date.
7. Horses on the Also-Eligible list shall be permitted to draw into races in order of their dates, earliest dates first, (Exception: when a race is removed from the turf. Dirt Preferred also-eligibles will have first preference to draw into the race in order of their date preference. If the race remains on the turf they will have no preference.)
8. No E-Date will be assigned to the second choice of an unsplit same-owner entry.



9. A horse which has been placed on a list (veterinarian, steward, starter or paddock judge) will lose their date and be assigned an R-Date corresponding to the day removed from list.
10. A horse which is a scheduled starter in a cancelled race will not receive an R-Date for that race but will retain its previous date.
11. The draw of stakes and handicap race is not subject to date preference.
12. Preference dates are transferred through change of ownership and changes in trainer after the proper transfer procedure have been completed through in the Steward's office and delivered to the Racing Secretary's office.
13. Date preference rules will not supersede KHRA rules regarding preference, eligibility or scratches.
14. Winners will be preferred in all non maiden races.

CONDITION ELIGIBILITY

Horses are preferred by their available conditions in all allowance races beginning with Graded Stakes winners (Grade I-II-III), open stakes winner through their allowance conditions providing the horse has finished 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th for \$40,000 or more since starting for less than \$40,000. In allowance/optional claiming races a horse's eligibility cannot exceed the condition of the race. Starter races for less than \$25,000 will be considered as claiming races for condition eligibility.

WINNERS ARE PREFERRED IN ALL NON MAIDEN RACES.

Also-Eligibles

If there are any scratches in a race with also-eligibles, the also-eligible horses will be permitted to move into the race in order of their preference.

On January 20, 2016 the KHRC received the attached letter from Keeneland with its KTDF purse structure request for the upcoming 2016 spring meet.

KHRC staff confirms that at the end of the 2015 fall meet, Keeneland had a surplus of \$54,413.83. Keeneland proposed KTDF purses in the range of \$800,000. Keeneland's projections are based on a payout of approximately 75% of the amount carded and daily earnings of \$20,773.

The KTDF Advisory Committee met & reviewed the proposal on January 26, 2016 and approval is recommended.

Dear Committee Members:

Keeneland has reviewed our KTDF data and would like to card approximately \$800,000 in KTDF money for our upcoming April meet. We have determined this number based on the following information:

1. We had a surplus of \$54,413 following the conclusion of the October meet.
2. Assuming a 5% decline in handle, we are projecting approximate daily earnings of \$20,773.
3. We are assuming a payout percentage of approximately 75% of the amount carded;
4. We are projecting total KRM earnings of approximately \$330,000 for the eight months of operation;
5. We anticipate that KTDF purses will be approximately 16% of the purses for the races that are eligible for KTDF.

Keeneland will pay out KTDF funds through last place. A table containing the payout percentage by field size is attached.

We will evaluate the earnings and payout percentages several days into our race meet and may need to make adjustments if our actual earnings and payout percentages are significantly different from our assumptions.

On January 20, 2016 the KHRC received the attached letter from Churchill Downs with its KTDF purse structure request for the upcoming 2016 spring/summer meet.

KHRC staff confirms that at the end of the 2015 fall meet, Churchill Downs had a surplus of \$11,385.40. Churchill Downs proposed KTDF purses in the range of \$1,000,000 - \$1,300,000. Churchill Downs projections are based on a payout of approximately 85% of the amount carded and daily earnings of \$27,915.

The KTDF Advisory Committee met & reviewed the proposal on January 26, 2016 and approval is recommended.

Committee Members:

Churchill Downs has reviewed our purses and would like to card KTDF purses in the range of \$1,000,000 to \$1,300,000 for our upcoming spring meet. We have based the range on the following information:

1. Churchill Downs had a balance of \$11,386 at the end of our 2015 fall meet.
2. Our 2016 Spring meet will consist of 38 racing days, consistent with the 2014 and 2015 meet. We are projecting daily earnings of \$27,915, which is 2.1% lower than the \$28,514 earned in 2015 due to anticipated declines in handle consistent with expected industry trends.
3. For Spring 2016, we are assuming a KTDF payout percentage of 85% with anticipated KTDF disbursements of \$1,000,000 which would be down 1.1% from Spring 2015.
4. To encourage participation during the spring meet, we are again planning to pay KTDF purses from first to last to all eligible horses.

On January 28, 2016, the KHRC received the attached letter from Churchill Downs seeking permission from the Commission to approve eight backside improvement projects pursuant to 810 KAR 1:021.

Backside Improvement Fund projects for consideration:

1. Churchill Downs backside paving (phase 2).
2. Churchill Downs track warning system.
3. Churchill Downs dormitory boiler improvements.
4. Churchill Downs dormitory locks.
5. Churchill Downs backside heating & A/C units.
6. Churchill Downs backside security camera.
7. Churchill Downs backside electrical maintenance.
8. Churchill Downs pest control expenditures.

Total estimated cost for above projects: \$275,586.00

Churchill Downs has included a detailed description of each project, justification for the project as well as photographs and bids. All documentation, including photographs & bids, remain on file at the Commission and can be made available upon request.

Churchill Downs has \$477,103.90 in the Backside Improvement Fund and KHRC staff inspected the proposed projects on February 1, 2016. Upon completion of the projects, KHRC staff will inspect the repair work and confirm the improvements have been



completed. All invoices, photographs and communication will be kept on file for Commission review.



1. Churchill Downs Backside Paving (Phase 2)	\$99,400.00

Project #1 – Backside Paving Phase 2 - \$99,400

Justification: Churchill Downs has a large amount of asphalt paving in the backside that supports significant vehicle, horse, and pedestrian traffic. Despite routine maintenance efforts, some of the asphalt is starting to become uneven and could potentially create a safety issue. It is vitally important that we make the necessary repairs to re-pave the most problematic areas.

Scope of Work: Last year, the area is blue on the diagram below was paved as it was in most need of repair. This year we plan to re-pave the area in yellow as we view it as the 2nd highest priority when considering the current surface condition.





Itemized Cost Estimate: Please see attached multi-phased preliminary quote for cost of paving – we are in the process of trying to find more competitive bids.

Project #2 – Track Warning System - \$15,000

Justification: Churchill Downs currently has an audio alarm system to alert jockeys and backside personnel of any track safety/loose horse concern. There is not currently a visible signal to jockeys or exercise riders as they are riding and there are some concerns that the current alarm system sometimes cannot be heard while riding or throughout the barn area.

Scope of Work: The project will involve purchasing and installing nine solar-powered visual and audio alarming systems. These incremental safety devices will supplement the existing alarm system and improve the safety conditions during training and racing. The system we are considering is based upon the attached document describing the configuration location at Delaware Park.

Project #3 – Dormitory Boiler Room - \$32,000.00

Justification: Our dormitory consists of 114 rooms for rent with maximum occupancy of 228 persons. The facility was constructed in 1998 and is still using the original boiler. We have occasional complaints due to lack of warm water and, upon inspection, believe that the proposed repairs will help improve the situation for those that stay in the dormitory.

Scope of Work: The scope of work includes removing and disposing the existing hot water boiler as well as purchasing and installing a new 750,000 BTU boiler. This also includes all necessary water, gas, and electric hookups. The \$32,000 estimate for this project also includes an assumption that we may need to replace the current storage tank.

Itemized Cost Estimate: We have the attached written estimate for \$13,175 for boiler purchase and installation. Incremental to that is a verbal estimate of another \$18,000 if the storage water tank also needs to be replaced. This project will take place later in 2016 and will require additional bids and investigation regarding the storage tank.

Project #4 – Dormitory Locks - \$5,000.00

Justification: The locks on the dorm rooms are in constant need of maintenance. We are budgeting \$5,000 in 2016 to purchase replacement locks as many of the door locks are becoming worn out and can no longer be repaired. Also, as the keys are lost or worn, they are made in such a way that they cannot be replicated without using a special key blank which is more expensive.

Scope of Work: The \$5,000 estimate is to purchase an inventory of locks for the 112 rooms in the dormitory.

Itemized Cost Estimate: The \$5,000 is an initial estimate based on internet searches for pricing.

Project #5 – Backside Heating & AC Units - \$25,000.00

Justification: Each year we do annual maintenance to address the heating units as well as the window AC units in the barn. We have an annual budget for to repair and/or replace heating and AC units in the tack rooms and the dormitory.

Scope of Work: The \$25,000 is currently ear-marked for replacement window AC units and baseboard heaters.

Itemized Cost Estimate: The \$25,000 is based on a historical estimate not to be exceeded and the actual mix of window AC units and heaters will adjust based on relative amount of failures and available pricing.

Project #6 – Backside Security Cameras - \$42,480.00

Justification: To improve security surveillance, we would like to add nine new security cameras around the dormitory. These cameras also need to be tied in with our server, but the server is currently at full capacity for the number of cameras it can support.

Scope of Work: The project is to purchase and install nine new fixed cameras around the dormitory as well as to upgrade the server dedicated for security surveillance. There will also be one to two cameras focusing on activity across 4th street in the parking lot where many of our horsemen park.

Itemized Cost Estimate: The cost estimate is based on early quote from Siemens, who helps to maintain our security surveillance system. The email quote is attached below.

Project #7 – Backside Electrical Maintenance - \$16,706.00

Justification: Our barn and dormitory area is need of electrical maintenance repairs.

Scope of Work: The scope of work includes the removal and replacement of two damaged 200 Amp disconnects as well as other miscellaneous electric and lighting repairs to the barns, tack rooms, valve house, and dormitory. This also covers a safety electrical inspection for the backside to ensure everything is in working order prior use and occupancy of these backside locations.

Itemized Cost Estimate: The attached quote from Henderson Electric outlines the \$16,706 of electrical feeds to two barns and annual maintenance repairs that we will be making on the backside prior to the arrival of horses in March.

Project #8 – Pest Control \$40,000.00

Justification: Our barn and dormitory area are always in need of pest control in order to maintain a safe and clean environment for backside employees and horses.

Scope of Work: The scope of work includes routine pest control visits from Orkin for the barns, the dormitory, and also any low-lying areas that have any water retention risk, presenting risk of mosquito colonization. Churchill also takes preventive measures in the dorm to avoid risk of bed bugs.

Itemized Cost Estimate: The \$40,000 estimate is based on past quotes from Orkin for this same service.

Dear members of the Equine Drug Research Council:

We are writing on behalf of the Equine Sports Science Initiative (ESSI) at the University of Kentucky. This is a new multidisciplinary group working to advance the health and well being of the equine athlete through data-driven scientific inquiry. Initial participants include veterinarians from the Department of Veterinary Science (Gluck Center and the Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory), the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission, Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital, and a private practitioner.

One of the research priorities of ESSI is to investigate bone density in racehorses. At present, knowledge of bone density in horses is quite limited. Existing research has centered on the cannon bone and bucked shins, but our understanding is much less for other bones in the limb skeleton and the extent to which this may be a critical parameter in catastrophic injuries. In addition, there is increasing evidence that the administration of certain drugs may impact bone density and/or the ability of a horse to remodel bones in response to the biomechanical forces exerted on the limbs during racing.

Our research efforts studying bone density in equine athletes are underway. An immediate and ongoing priority is acquiring the essential tissue samples, both from racehorses and the appropriate controls, for the experiments. This is important not only for initial pilot studies to justify and refine experimental plans, but also to achieve the number of quality samples that will enable larger and statistically powerful analyses. Since the collection and archiving of samples will be a continuous and long-term commitment, we are writing to ask for support from the EDRC to purchase freezers and sample storage accessories. Attached is a list of the items that we would like to purchase.

Re: EDRC Funding Recommendation for research proposal, *Sex hormone binding globulin: a biomarker of anabolic abuse*; Dr. Barry Ball, University of Kentucky.

This proposal intends to develop an immunoassay for equine sex-hormone binding globulin. Following the development of an assay of sufficient sensitivity and specificity, the investigators propose to determine the SHBG concentrations in a range of study groups including: adult intact males, prepuberal males, non-gravid females, and gravid females. The investigators will then administer 3 anabolic steroids (testosterone, boldenone, and stanozolol) to study horses to determine the effect of the administration of exogenous anabolic steroids on SHBG.

The investigators hypothesize that determinations of SHBG may be used to identify horses under the effect of anabolic steroids. Test results would not be sufficient to establish that a rule violation had occurred, but rather provide intelligence that would be used to initiate further investigation and/or monitoring of a specific horse or population subset.

Upon completion of the initial review process by the Research Advisory Working Group (Dean Nancy Cox, Drs. Michael Kilgore, Andy Roberts, Mary Scollay, Johnny Mac Smith, and Ed Squires), the investigators were asked to provide additional information with respect to:

- 1) Justification for the number of horses in each of the study groups
- 2) The statistical methods to be applied
- 3) Source of exogenous anabolic steroids
- 4) Revision of introductory language to more accurately reflect horse racing's current regulations of anabolic steroids.
- 5) Information, if known, about breed differences

The revised proposal was received on December 8, and the reviewers' questions were satisfactorily answered.

On December 9, 2015, the Kentucky Equine Drug Research Council (EDRC) voted unanimously in favor of funding this research proposal. The EDRC recommends that funding of the second aim of the study be contingent upon successful completion of the first (development of the SHBG immunoassay).




Total Historical Racing Handle - Combined Ky Downs, Ellis Park, KRM








Total Historical Racing Handle - Combined Ky Downs, Ellis Park, KRM




