**Applications Being Accepted for Participation in
Non-Race Kentucky Horse Breeders' Incentive Fund**

LEXINGTON, Ky. – (Oct. 27, 2014) – The Kentucky Horse Racing Commission announced today they are seeking applications to participate in the Kentucky Horse Breeders' Incentive Fund (KHBIF). The KHBIF was established in 2005 and consists of 7 percent of all taxes collected for breeding a stallion to a mare in the state of Kentucky. The fund is often referred to as "Non-Race" because the fund was set aside for all other breeds to earn money competing in shows and contests, rather than racing. The KHBIF operates on a three year cycle and will cover 2015, 2016, and 2017.

Applications must be postmarked no later than Nov. 1, 2014, with all required information for review and approval by the KHBIF Advisory Committee and the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission. Applications should be mailed to:
