Acting on the report from the HFL Sport Science Laboratory, the official testing laboratory for the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission, and confirmed by Louisiana State University Equine Medication Surveillance Laboratory (#SS00978), the sample taken from **MAKE A FORTUNE** who finished 1st in the fourth race at Churchill Downs on May 26, 2012 contained the prohibited substance Guanabenz (Class B) and an overage of Furosemide. **MAKE A FORTUNE** is disqualified and placed last. All purse monies must be returned to the association. The official order of finish and purse redistribution is;

- 2nd #8 DOUBLE RAH RAH
- 3rd #6 SHOW ME THE WAY
- 4th #1 JAZZ HON
- 5th #3 USKA'S WALL CAT
- 6th #2 SIR MARCHAND
