Acting on the report from the HFL Sport Science Laboratory, the official testing laboratory for the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission, the sample taken from FORTUNE PLAY who finished eighth in the third race at Churchill Downs on May 3, 2013 contained Testosterone (Class B drug). FORTUNE PLAY is disqualified and all purse money forfeited. All purse monies must be returned to the association. The purse of this race is ordered redistributed as follows:
