---


The parties having agreed, and the Hearing Officer being sufficiently advised,





Acting on the report from the HPL Sport Science Laboratory, the official testing laboratory for the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission, and confirmed at Louisiana State University Equine Medication Surveillance Laboratory, sample number 0018996 taken from ENGLISH CLASS, who finished second in the ninth race at Keeneland on October 19, 2012, contained Methocarbamol (class C drug) at a concentration of 2.1 ng/ml. After a formal hearing before the Board of Stewards you are hereby fined TWO HUNDRED FIFTY (\$250.00) DOLLARS. ENGLISH CLASS is disqualified and all purse money forfeited. Pari-mutuel wagering is not affected by this ruling. Upon your receipt of this ruling, you are required within thirty (30) days to pay any and all fines imposed by this ruling to the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission. Failure to do so will subject you to summary suspension of your license pursuant to 810 KAR 1:025 Section 14 (cc).
