TRACK: Sandy Ridge at the Red Mile

DATE: March 24, 2025

LICENSEE: Francisco Quintero

After a hearing before the Board of Stewards, Francisco Quintero, who rode Lot T Dot T in the 2nd race at Sandy Ridge at the Red Mile on March 17, 2025, was found to have violated the crop regulation. This being his first offense at this meet in Kentucky, Francisco Quintero is hereby fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) for his improper use of the riding crop by exceeding the allowable use of the riding crop in the overhand manner.

Additionally, Francisco Quintero who rode Stolin Home Brew in the 6th race at Sandy Ridge at the Red Mile on March 18, 2025, was found to have violated the crop regulation by making contact with the horse more than two (2) successive strikes without allowing the horse a chance to respond. Francisco Quintero is hereby fined an additional FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00). HOWEVER, this fine is suspended provided Francisco Quintero has no further infractions during the duration of the Sandy Ridge at the Red Mile meet in 2025.

Upon receipt of this Ruling, Francisco Quintero is required within thirty (30) days to pay any and all fines imposed to the Kentucky Horse Racing and Gaming Corporation. Failure to do so will subject the licensee to summary suspension of license pursuant to 800 KAR 3:020 Section 15 (cc).
