4<sup>th</sup> RACE An objection was lodged by the rider of second place #12 "Wait for Nastrobi" (Santiago Gonzalez) alleging interference by the rider of the unofficial winner #7 "Twenty Carat" (Gerardo Corrales) in the stretch. After reviewing the race replay and interviewing the riders, the stewards determined that #7 made contact with #12 leaving the 1/4 pole and continued to drift out through the stretch, carrying the #12 out in the final stages. For the interference #7 was disqualified and placed second behind #12.  
Official order of finish: 12-7-13-8

5<sup>th</sup> RACE #8 "Fast Fire" (Alex Canchari) was a late scratch from the post parade on the advice of the KHRC veterinarian.


A Stewards Inquiry was posted regarding an incident near the 5-1/2 pole that involved several horses. After reviewing the race replay and interviewing the riders of the unofficial winner #6 "Made in America" (Declan Cannon), third place #5 "Lookin to Strike" (Rafael Hernandez), fourth place #12 "Unmoored" (Jermaine V. Bridmohan), eighth place #1 "What's Up Dude" (Chris Landeros) and tenth place #2 "Bango" (Gerardo Corrales), the stewards determined that #12 continued to angle in from the start while not clear and created a chain reaction that caused all of the horses mentioned to check and lose momentum. For the interference #12 was disqualified and placed tenth, behind #2.  
Official order of finish: 6-7-5-9


The winner #6 "Made in America" BLEED while in the test barn.


6<sup>th</sup> RACE #2 "Miss Eau de Vie" (Gerardo Corrales) was pulled up at the 1/4 pole and required the assistance of the KHRC veterinarians and the horse ambulance. The filly had suffered a catastrophic injury to her right hind leg and was humanely euthanized.

An objection was lodged by the rider of third place #6 "Chotaw Bingo" (Santiago Gonzalez) alleging interference by the rider of second place #8 "Pliantia" (Rafael Bejarano) near the 5/16 pole. After reviewing the race replay and interviewing the riders, the stewards determined that there was no interference and the race was posted official.
