1st RACE A Stewards' Inquiry was posted when both #2 "Super d'Oro (Thiago Canuto) and #8 "What the Elle" (Brian Hernandez, Jr.) fell and unseated their riders nearing the 1/16 pole. After reviewing the race replay, the stewards determined that #2 drifted in slightly and clipped the heel of third place #3 "Tiz the Journey" (Reylu Gutierrez) and fell. #8 was unable to avoid the fallen rival and fell over him. #2 was not injured and left the track on his own power. #8 required the assistance of the KHRC veterinarians and the horse ambulance. It was determined that he had a catastrophic injury to his right shoulder and he was humanely euthanized.

2nd RACE #8 "Bellinger" (Adam Beschizza) was pulled up abruptly at the 3/8 pole and required the assistance of the KHRC veterinarians and the horse ambulance. It was determined that the horse had a catastrophic injury to his right foreleg and he was humanely euthanized. A claim that been submitted for the horse was voided.

6th RACE A Stewards' Inquiry was posted involving the start of #12 "Maven" (E.T. Baird). In addition, an objection was lodged by the rider of fifth place #6 "Get Western" (Corey Lanerle) alleging interference by the rider of fourth place #9 "Ship It Red" (Francisco Arrieta) in the stretch. After reviewing the race replay and interviewing the riders, there was insufficient evidence to warrant a disqualification and the objection was disallowed.

After reviewing the start of the race and interviewing the rider of #12 and the starter, the stewards determined that #12 charged the front doors, popping the door open slightly before the break. The assistant starter instinctively attempted to hold onto #12, causing to him break awkwardly and inward, and precluding him from obtaining a fair start. The stewards declared #12 "Maven" a NON STARTER and ordered all wagers refunded. The mutual department made the proper refunds.
