

8th RACE A Stewards Inquiry was posted shortly after the start when #8 "Paddock Boss"(Alex Achard), fell while in tight quarters near the 7 ½ furlong pole and unseated his rider. Because Achard appeared to be injured and was unable to be immediately moved, the stewards took the necessary steps to have the field pull up by activating the alarm system and alerting the outriders and announcer. The horses were safely stopped near the ¼ pole without incident and the race was declared a NO CONTEST. The mutuels department made the proper refunds. It was determined by the KHRC veterinarians that Paddock Boss had suffered a catastrophic injury, and he was humanely euthanized on the racetrack. Achard was transported to the hospital, and it was later reported that he had escaped serious injury.

9th RACE CLEAR

10th RACE #3 "Jace's Road" (Florent Geroux) unseated his rider behind the starting gate and ran loose. The horse was caught by the outrider, inspected and approved by the KHRC veterinarian and raced without incident

11th RACE #1 "Regimental" got loose on racetrack on his way to the paddock and evaded the outriders for quite some time until he was finally scratched by the stewards.
