STEWARDS RULING

Ruling number: 15-0027
LGC Sample #0058275

Track: Turfway Park

Date: March 8, 2015

Owner/Trainer: Laurie L. Halmi

Upon receipt of notification from LGC Science, Inc., the official testing laboratory for the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission, and confirmed at Industrial Laboratories (Lab ID # S-15-07), sample number 0058275 taken from FLYAWAY BABY, who finished third in the second race at Turfway Park on January 4, 2015 contained the methocarbamol at a level of 1.8 ng/ml in blood (Class C drug) and dexamethasone at a level of 64 pg/ml in blood (Class C drug). After a formal hearing before the Board of Stewards you are hereby suspended TEN (10) days, March 23, 2015 through April 1, 2015 (inclusive) and fined FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00) DOLLARS. FLYAWAY BABY is disqualified and all purse money forfeited. Pari-Mutuel wagering is not affected by this ruling. During her suspension Ms. Halmi is denied the privileges of all facilities under the jurisdiction of the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission. Entry of all horses owned or trained by Ms. Halmi is denied pending transfer to persons acceptable to the stewards. Upon receipt of this ruling, you are required within thirty (30) days to pay any and all fines imposed to the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission. Failure to do so will subject you to summary suspension of your license pursuant to 810 KAR 1:025 Section 14 (cc).
