STEWARDS RULING

Upon receipt of notification from LGC Science, Inc., the official chemist for the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission sample number 0067768 taken from BUCK ROY in the second race at Keeneland on April 24, 2015 was found to contain multiple NSAIDS, phenylbutazone at a level of 1.3 ng/ml in blood and flunixin at a level of 10.7 in blood. Concentrations of both permitted NSAIDS are below the primary threshold and above the secondary threshold (first offense in 365 days). After waiving your right to a formal hearing before the Board of Stewards you are hereby fined TWO HUNDRED FIFTY (\$250.00) DOLLARS. Purse monies and pari-mutuel wagering are not affected by this ruling. Upon receipt of this ruling you have thirty (30) days to pay any and all fines imposed by this ruling to the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission. Failure to do so will subject you to summary suspension of your license pursuant to 810 KAR 1:025 Section 14 (cc).
