STEWARDS RULING

Ruling number: 15-0088
LGC Sample #0060456

Track: Churchill Downs

Date: June 20, 2015

Owner/Trainer: Brendan P. Walsh

Upon receipt of notification from LGC Science, Inc., the official testing laboratory for the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission, and confirmed at Texas A & M Veterinary Medical Diagnostic Laboratory, sample number 0060456 taken from SAHAM, who finished third in the eighth race at Keeneland on April 15, 2015 contained Multiple NSAIDS. Concentrations of 1 permitted NSAID above the primary threshold and 2 above the secondary threshold (ketoprofen 17 ng/ml in blood, phenylbutazone .82 ug/ml in blood and flunixin 7.6 ng/ml in blood). After waiving your right to a formal hearing before the Board of Stewards you are hereby suspended TEN (10) days, July 5, 2015 through July 14, 2015 (inclusive) and fined FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00) DOLLARS. SAHAM is disqualified and all purse money forfeited. Pari-mutuel wagering is not affected by this ruling. During his suspension Mr. Walsh is denied the privileges of all facilities under the jurisdiction of the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission. Entry of all horses owned or trained by Mr. Walsh is denied pending transfer to persons acceptable to the stewards. Upon receipt of this ruling, you are required within thirty (30) days to pay any and all fines imposed to the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission. Failure to do so will subject you to summary suspension of your license pursuant to 810 KAR 1:025 Section 14 (cc).
