## STEWARDS RULING

Ruling number: 22-0063

Track: Churchill Downs

Date: May 11, 2022

Jockey: Mitchell Murrill

After waiving his right to a hearing before the Board of Stewards, Mitchell Murrill, who rode WARRIOR JOHNNY in the first race at Churchill Downs on May 7, 2022 was found to have violated the crop regulation. This being his first offense, Mr. Murrill was given the option and chose to pay a fine. Mitchell Murrill is hereby fined FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00) DOLLARS for his improper use of the riding crop by exceeding the allowable use in the overhand manner. Upon receipt of this ruling, it is required within thirty (30) days to pay any and all fines imposed to the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission. Failure to do so will subject the licensee to summary suspension of license pursuant to 810 KAR 3:020 Section 15 (cc).
