1st RACE Superfecta, Trifecta and Show wagering were not offered when the field was reduced to four prior to the opening of wagering.

Voided claim - no track listed
Voided claim - insufficient funds

#4 "Tapage" (Tyler Gaffalione) was injured in the starting gate and was a late scratch on the advice of the KHRC veterinarian. The scratch reduced the field to three, necessitating the cancellation of Exacta wagering. Management also elected to cancel Place wagering. The mutuels department made the proper refunds. A claim that had been submitted for #4 was voided.

2nd RACE

Voided claim - used stable name only
Voided claim - envelope incorrectly completed

#2 "Desert Highway" (Walter A. Rodriguez) was scratched by the stewards when he unseated his rider in the post parade and ran loose, evading the outriders.

A Stewards Inquiry was posted involving the top two finishers and, in addition, an objection was lodged by the rider of second place #4 "Apollo Rising" (Rafael Bejarano) alleging interference by the rider of the unofficial winner #9 "Rush Center" (James Graham) in the stretch. After reviewing the race replay and interviewing the riders, the stewards determined that #9 ducked in at the top of the stretch and caused #4 to steady and lose momentum. For the interference, #9 was disqualified and placed second, behind #4.

A blood sample was drawn and the horse was excused from the test barn. It was determined that the horse had returned lame and he was placed on the See State Vet list.
