1st RACE #5 "I Am Freaky Fast (Joseph Talamo) unseated her rider in the post parade and escaped. The filly was quickly apprehended by the outrider, remounted, and started.

2nd RACE #8 "Run the Tap" (Brian Hernandez, Jr.) was pulled up after the race and required the assistance of the KHRC veterinarians and the horse ambulance. It was later reported that the horse was transported to a local clinic. It was presumed that she had suffered a fractured pelvis and later died at the clinic from her injuries

3rd RACE CLEAR

4th RACE Voided 2 claims - owners not licensed

#5 "A Mo Reay" (Luis Saez) drifted out and was eased near the 1/4 pole. The filly was pulled up just before the finish and left the track on her own power.

5th RACE After the running of the race the correct order of finish (3-9-8-10) posted by the placing judges and made official by the stewards, was subsequently changed due to an override in the tote department that caused the tote board to display an incorrect order of finish (3-8-9-10) and payoffs. There was a nearly 20 minute delay to the start of race 6 as the mutuels department worked to correct the error and re-post the correct order of finish and corresponding payoffs.



Re: Race 5 at Keeneland Association Conducted on April 8, 2022

On April 8, 2022, the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering and Compliance staff was informed of an issue related to the order of finish and subsequent price calculations for Race 5 conducted by Keeneland Association on April 8, 2022. Upon the conclusion of Race 5, the Stewards and Placing Judges followed standard protocol. The Placing Judges entered a "3-9-8-10" order of finish into the United Tote Phoenix system. This displayed an unofficial order of finish on the field board for the betting public. Consequently, the Chief State Steward communicated a "3-9-8-10" order of finish to the Keeneland Mutuels Department via phone and gave the order to consider the race official. Keeneland Mutuels Department communicated this order of finish to United Tote. The United Tote personnel ("Operator") logged this order of finish into a paper logbook. Under normal operating conditions, the Operator compares the order of finish communicated by the Stewards to the order of finish shown on the field board, which originated from the Placing Judges. However, the camera feed that is utilized to perform this check was not operational. Therefore, the Operator overrode the placing judges' order of finish with a "3-8-9-10" order of finish. Therefore, due to human error, the Operator made the results official with the incorrect order of finish.

The officials and members of the public noticed the shift in the unofficial order of finish and the official order of finish. Subsequently, price calculations, which are a part of the automated processes that take place after an order of finish is deemed official, were performed and communicated to all sites betting into the associated host pools for Race 5. Once this issue was brought to United Tote's attention, payouts were suspended for winning tickets at Keeneland.

Pursuant to 810 KAR 6:020, the official order of finish must be used to calculate prices and issue payouts to any winning tickets. Therefore, United Tote re-calculated the prices based on the correct order of finish and the winning tickets based on the official order of finish were eligible for payouts. In order to avoid these issues in the future, United Tote and Keeneland has modified its procedures to eliminate the Operator's ability to override the placing judges order of finish.
