1st **CLEAR** RACE

RACE #9 "Chloe's Dream" (Corey Lanerie) was pulled up abruptly near the 3/4 pole and required the assistance of the KHRC veterinarians and the horse ambulance. After examination it was determined that the horse had suffered a catastrophic injury to his right knee and he was humanely euthanized.

- 3rd RACE An objection was lodged by the rider of second place #5 "King Ottoman" (Jose Ortiz) alleging interference by the unofficial winner #14 "Petulante" (Luis Saez) near the 1/8 pole. After reviewing the race replay and interviewing the riders, the stewards determined that there had been no interference and the race was posted official.
- RACE Super Hi-5 wagering was not offered when it was mistakenly listed as a betting option in the official program on a race that was carded with six horses, a field that did not qualify for Super Hi-5 wagering.
- 5th RACE Super Hi-5 wagering was not offered when the field was reduced to six prior to the opening of wagering.

8th RACE #14 "Freezing Point" (Corey Lanerie) was pulled up abruptly near the 5/8 pole and required the assistance of the KHRC veterinarians and the horse ambulance. After diagnostics were performed by the private veterinarian it was determined that the horse had suffered a serious injury to his left foreleg and he was humanely euthanized.

9th RACE #4 "Talk of the Nation" (Tyler Gaffalione) ws a late scratch from the post parade on the advice of the KHRC veterinarian.

14th RACE There was a 15 minute weather delay as a strong thunderstorm passed through the area. The storm required the track to be reconditioned before the horses entered the post parade. During the delay the horses remained in the paddock without incident.
