4<sup>th</sup> RACE Voided claim - no funds

#5 "Dealing Justice" (Keith Asmussen) finished  
fifth while suffering an injury approaching the finish, and required the  
assistance of the KHRGC veterinarians and the horse ambulance. After  
diagnostics were performed, it was determined that the mare had suffered  
a catastrophic injury to her right foreleg and she was humanely euthanized.  
A claim that had been submitted for the horse was voided.

5<sup>th</sup> RACE #7 "Quadra Island" (Luan Machado) was a late  
scratch from the post parade on the advice of the KHRGC veterinarian. The  
scratch reduced the field to six, necessitating the cancellation of the Super  
Hi-5. The mutuels department made the proper refunds.
