1st RACE Odd vs. Even wagering was not offered when only two horses with odd numbers remained in after scratches, in conflict with the rules governing the wager.

2nd RACE There was a 20 minute weather delay due to lightning that passed through the area. The horses and riders were returned to the paddock from the post parade and remained there until it was safe for them to return to the racing strip. The race was eventually run without incident.

3rd RACE CLEAR

5th RACE During the post parade, a lead pony was injured and required the assistance of the KHRG veterinarians and the horse ambulance. The field remained on the track and continued to warm up during the slight delay.

6th RACE An objection was lodged by the trainer (Gregory D. Foley) of #1 "Vamos Carlitos" (Edgar Morales) alleging interference by the rider of the unofficial winner #8 "Bring the Smoke" (Tyler Gaffalione) in the stretch. After reviewing the race replay and interviewing the riders, the stewards determined that there had been no interference and the race was posted official.

7th RACE Prior permission had been requested by management and granted by the KHRG to offer Superfecta wagering on this Graded Stakes race that was carded with five betting interests. Prior to the opening of wagering a scratch reduced the field to four. As a result, Superfecta and Trifecta wagering were not offered. Management also opted to not offer Show wagering.

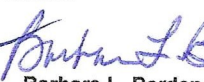

11th RACE Management made a similar request to retain Superfecta wagering on this Graded Stakes race that was carded with 7 in the event that the field was reduced to 5 prior to the opening of wagering, which it was. As a result, Superfecta wagering was offered on the 5 horse field with permission of the KHRG. Odd vs. Even wagering was not offered.

#5 "Magnitude" (Jose L. Ortiz) broke through the gate prior to the start, but the assistant starter heroically kept the horse from getting loose and the rider stayed aboard. The horse was examined and approved by the KHRG veterinarians, reloaded, and the start was without incident.
