Eligibility & Rules:

1. All entries must be a Kentucky-bred as defined by 810 KAR 7:040.
2. Entry Fee: \$250 for each leg; no entry fee on Final.
3. All entries must be made at the time designated on the racetrack condition sheet.
4. All entries are subject to approval by the racetrack Race Secretary.
5. 45-day rule will be in effect & all entries must meet the racetrack qualifying standards.
6. There must be at least 4 entries, or the leg(s) may be canceled by the Race Secretary.
7. Horses must start in a minimum of two (2) legs to be eligible for the Final.
8. All KHRC paperwork must be completed.
9. All owners, trainers, grooms, and drivers must have a KHRC license.
10. The top 8 points earners in the legs will make the Final.
11. Race Associations and the KHRC have the final decision on any disputes that might arise.
12. There shall be eight (8) horses on the gate and the race shall split at eleven (11) horses.

By entering, all involved agree to the rules of the 4YO Series at Oak Grove.

Red Mile

(Conditions)

2023 Kentucky Sire Stakes, Commonwealth & Goldenrod

To be eligible, horses must have met all requirements of 810 KAR 7:040. Entry fee for a Kentucky Sire Stakes (KYSS) – Championship Series preliminary leg is \$500, \$150 for all Commonwealth preliminary legs and \$75 for all Golden Rod preliminary legs. There are no starting fees for entry into any of the Finals.

COMMONWEALTH SERIES

2YO and 3YO

Horses may move up and down between the series, but points only accumulate in each series and are not combined at any time between the series. For example, if a horse placed first in one (1) leg of the Championship Series, one (1) leg of the Commonwealth Series and one (1) leg of the Goldenrod Series; the horse will have 50 points in each series (not a combined total of 150 points). For purposes of the Kentucky Sire Stakes – Championship Series Final, Commonwealth Series Final and Goldenrod Series Final, all provisions of 810 KAR 7:040 govern. In the event a horse is one of the top ten point earners in more than one series at the conclusion of all the preliminary legs, the horse must race in the series final with the highest purse in the following order: Kentucky Sire Stakes – Championship Series Final, Commonwealth Series Final & Goldenrod Series Final. For example, a horse that is a leading point earner in the Commonwealth Series and the Kentucky Sire Stakes - Championship Series must race in the Kentucky Sires Stakes – Championship Series Final.

If a horse does not qualify for the Kentucky Sire Stakes - Championship Final, the horse may be considered an also eligible (AE) for the Commonwealth Final based on points earned in the Championship Series (to fill the Commonwealth Series, if necessary). Preference for entry in the Commonwealth Final will be given to horses earning points in the Commonwealth Series. For example, if eight horses enter for the Commonwealth Final, those horses will draw for post positions 1-8, and post positions 9 & 10 will be drawn from the two highest point earning AE horses that were eligible to enter in the Championship Final as AEs.

If a horse does not qualify for the Commonwealth Final, the horse may be considered an also eligible (AE) for the Goldenrod Final based on points earned in the Commonwealth Series (to fill the Goldenrod Series, if necessary). Preference for entry in the Goldenrod Final will be given to horses earning points in the Goldenrod Series. For example, if eight horses enter for the Goldenrod Final, those horses will draw for post positions 1-8, and post positions 9 & 10 will be drawn from the two highest point earning AE horses that were eligible to enter in the Commonwealth Final as AEs.

Stallion Bonus

Beginning with the 2021 breeding season, KYSS will offer a Stallion Bonus program. Any horse that results from a stallion standing in Kentucky and a mare residing in Kentucky for 180 days, as well as nominated to the program, is eligible to receive a 50% bonus if finishing 1st-5th in all legs and the finals of the Championship and Commonwealth Series Programs.

2. Entry Fee: \$250 for each leg; no entry fee on Final for 2YO, 3YO & 4YO series.
3. All entries must be made at the time designated on the racetrack condition sheet.
4. All entries are subject to approval by the racetrack Race Secretary.
5. 45-day rule will be in effect.
6. All entries must meet the racetrack qualifying standards
7. There must be at least 4 entries or the leg(s) may be canceled
8. All KHRC paperwork must be completed.
9. All owners, trainers, grooms, and drivers must have a KHRC license.
10. The top eight (8) point earners in the legs shall make the Finals.
11. Race Associations and the KHRC have the final decision on any disputes that might arise.
12. There shall be eight (8) horses on the gate and the race shall split at eleven (11) horses.
