**Description and Information about New and Amended
Administrative Regulations Filed on October 21, 2021**

The KHRC filed the following new and amended administrative regulations on October 21, 2021:

1. 810 KAR 8:025E

- A. Summary of Administrative Regulation: This emergency regulatory amendment is promulgated to meet an imminent threat to public health, safety, or welfare, and to prevent a loss of state funds. On October 5, 2021, 810 KAR 8:025 became effective. Shortly thereafter, it was observed that this newly-promulgated regulation contained a typographical error, which provided self-contradictory thresholds for clenbuterol and procaine penicillin. This contradictory guidance regarding mandatory threshold limits provides confusing and erroneous information to trainers and veterinarians about the appropriate threshold for clenbuterol and procaine penicillin in Kentucky. This administrative regulation is filed on an emergency basis to ensure public health, safety, and welfare, as well as to ensure the continuation of horse racing at Kentucky tracks.

Information about the public hearing and public comment period for this regulation: A public hearing on this administrative regulation shall be held on December 22, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. EST at the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission, 4063 Iron Works Parkway, Building B, Lexington, KY 40511 via Zoom. Individuals interested in being heard at this hearing shall notify this agency in writing by five workdays prior to the hearing, of their intent to attend. If no notification of intent to attend the hearing is received by that date, the hearing may be cancelled. This hearing is open to the public. Any person who wishes to be heard will be given an opportunity to comment on the proposed administrative regulation. A transcript of the public hearing will not be made, unless a written request for a transcript is made. If you do not wish to be heard at the public hearing, you may submit written comments on the proposed administrative regulation. Written comments shall be accepted through 11:59 p.m. EST on December 31, 2021. 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2. 810 KAR 8:025

- A. Summary of Administrative Regulation: This amendment will correct a typographical errors, in order to clearly state the mandatory threshold levels for clenbuterol and procaine penicillin. Additionally, this amendment will correct numbering errors, which were discovered after filing.
